

## **iBook Care**

The iBook belongs to the Maine Department of Education. It is on loan to you as a tool for learning. The iBook does not belong to you.

The iBook is fun to use, but it is not a toy! Remember that it is a computer, and you are expected to handle it with care.

If you mishandle your iBook, your privilege to use it may be revoked. Use of the iBook is strictly a privilege, not a right.

### **iBook Care:**

- Never put your iBook in your backpack. It is issued with a case to protect it. The iBook must be transported in this case at all times.
- Always use the iBook on a flat, stable surface so it does not slide or fall.
- Never put things in the ports (openings) on the sides of the iBook.
- You will be assigned a slot in the charging station for storing your iBook and charging its battery. Use only your assigned space.

### **iBook Cleaning:**

- Keep the foam slip on the keyboard when closing the iBook to keep finger grease off the screen.

**Never touch the iBook screen.**

**Never use water or cleaning solutions on the iBook or its screen.**
